The purpose of this report is to inform the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board that Social Services and Employment Minister Steve Maharey announced that New Zealand will have its own Children's Day on **29 October** this year. Children's Day 2000 is a joint initiative between government and community agencies. Primary agencies involved with the day are Child, Youth and Family, Barnardos and the Office of the Commissioner of Children. The day, chosen to occur on the last Sunday each October, will hopefully become an annual event where all communities in New Zealand are encouraged to have special activities where adults spend time with children.

Spending time with children is the major theme of Children's Day. There are four other key messages:

- New experiences
