The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to formalise the Give Way sign in Pannell Avenue at the intersections of Kerrs Road and Wainoni Road

Road works carried out in Pannell Avenue during 1999 to renew the roadway, kerbs, channels, and berms also provided the opportunity to install a threshold treatment at the intersection of Kerrs Road. A threshold was installed at the intersection of Pannell Avenue at Wainoni Road in 1995. The need for traffic calming at these intersections was identified in the Wainoni, Local Area Traffic Management Scheme. In turn the installation of the thresholds have provided the opportunity to install 'Give Way' controls at both these intersections.

It is now appropriate to formalise the installation of the Give Way signs.

Recommendations:

- 1. That the Board approve the installation of a "Give Way" sign in Pannell Avenue at its intersection with Kerrs Road.
- 2. That the Board approve the installation of a "Give Way" sign in Pannell Avenue at its intersection with Wainoni Road.
