

11. AORANGI ROAD - PROPOSED GIVE WAY SIGN

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for a Give Way sign to be installed against Aorangi Road at its uncontrolled intersection with Ilam Road.

BACKGROUND

The Board approved alterations to the intersection of Aorangi and Ilam Roads last year and following a postponement of the work to allow the St. Stephens Church time to undertake some alterations to its carpark first, it is presently under construction. The matter however of a proposed Give Way restriction against Aorangi Road as shown on the publicity plan was not resolved at the time.

The situation is that there is an adequate sight distance in both directions along Ilam Road for a driver doing a right turn from Aorangi Road. However there is likely to be some confusion over turning priorities when a vehicle from Ilam Road (a collector road carrying 6,300 vehicles per day) and a vehicle from Aorangi Road (a local road carrying 3,000 vehicles per day) wish to turn right at the same time.

PROPOSAL

That a Give Way sign, as recommended in the New Zealand Land Transport's manual of regulatory signs and markings, is installed against Aorangi Road to control the intersection.

Recommendation: That a Give Way sign be placed against Aorangi Road at its intersection with Ilam Road.
