BACKGROUND

Feedback from the residents in response to the publicity pamphlet was as follows:

• Unconditionally for the proposal	18
• Conditionally for the proposal	6
• With no comment	1
• Conditionally against the proposal	1
• Unconditionally against the proposal	2
Total	<u>28</u>

This shows that 86% of respondents support the proposal as shown on the **following** plan.

PROPOSAL

To install a threshold and three low profile speed humps in Reynolds Avenue as shown on the submitted plan.
