

7. FERRYMEAD PARK DRIVE – GIVE WAY

The purpose of this report is to gain Board approval for the installation of a “Give Way” against Ferrymead Park Drive at its intersection with Bridle Path Road.

Ferrymead Park Drive is the main traffic route to the Ferrymead Historic Park and Bridle Path Road is a minor arterial that services the Heathcote Valley community. To avoid any confusion for right turning traffic from Bridle Path Road and Ferrymead Park Drive, it is recommended that a “Give Way” be installed.

A “Give Way” control against Ferrymead Park Drive would improve safety at the intersection.

Recommendation: That a “Give Way” sign be placed against Ferrymead Park Drive at its intersection with Bridle Path Road.
