

8. ST ASAPH STREET – PARKING RESTRICTION

On the corner of St Asaph Street and Fitzgerald Avenue is a branch of the National Bank and along the St Asaph Street frontage is an ATM machine. At present there is no restriction on parking on St Asaph Street and this area is quite often occupied all day. A P5 parking restriction would ease congestion on this corner and make parking available for short term transactions.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 5 minutes on the north side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 8 metres from its intersection with Fitzgerald Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
