

12. ST ALBANS EAST LOCAL AREA TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME

The purpose of this report is to present the draft St Albans East Local Area Traffic Management Scheme to the Community Board and gain approval to circulate it to the public for comment. (A copy of the LATMS and a copy of the summary document have been circulated separately to Board members.)

A well attended public meeting was held on Thursday 20 May 1999 to consider traffic safety improvements for inclusion in the LATMS. The issues raised are outlined in the list of concerns in the draft plan.

The LATMS has been prepared by the City Streets Unit in close consultation with the Environmental Policy and Planning Unit and Parks Unit.

The City Streets Unit is also assisting with the development of the St Albans Neighbourhood Plan. The parallel preparation of this plan has presented an ideal opportunity for constructive two way interchange of information, ideas and concepts. It is anticipated that both documents will be considerably enhanced by this process.

A special edition of "Our Environment" launching the St Albans Neighbourhood Plan was delivered to 3,600 properties on 23rd December 1999. An article on the St Albans East Local Area Traffic Management Scheme was included.
