

## 7. BOWER AVENUE - P30 PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The purpose of this report is to recommend to Council the installation of a P30 parking restriction outside the QE II Food Market/Dairy on Bower Avenue.

Frequently while events are in progress at the Queen Elizabeth II Park short term kerb-side parking is not available for shoppers to the Food Market/Dairy on Bower Avenue. The Food Market/Dairy owner has requested a time limit parking restriction be formed in front of his shop between the corner of Travis Road and the existing bus stop. No other shop entrances of the shopping centre are accessible from Bower Avenue. All shops in this shopping centre have access from off street parking facilities from Travis Road.

The Parking Operations Manager is agreeable to the installation of a P30 parking restriction in this area.

**Recommendation:** That the Board recommend the following parking change to Council:

That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the western side of Bower Avenue, commencing at a point 18 metres from its intersection with Travis Road and extending in a northern direction for a distance of 25 metres.
