

## 8. JOY STREET - GIVE WAY SIGN

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to formalise the Give Way sign in Joy Street at the intersection of Lake Terrace Road.

The proposal to construct a traffic island on Joy Street, was in response to traffic safety concerns at the intersection from residents, and is shown in the draft copy of the Shirley East Local Area Traffic Management Scheme. A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in September 1999, and was generally accepted (*see page 27*). This work was completed in December 1999.

It is now appropriate to formalise the installation of the Give Way sign.

**Recommendation:** That the Board approve the installation of a “Give Way” sign in Joy Street at its intersection with Lake Terrace Road.
