The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to request Council for approval to install a P10 parking restriction at the intersection of Gayhurst and McBratneys Roads.

The shop operators on the southeastern corner of Gayhurst Road and McBratneys Road have requested that parking outside their shops be restricted to 10 minutes. There is concern that the parking spaces outside their shops are being used for long-term parking by motorists using the nearby bus services, and medical facilities. This is reducing the number of available parking spaces adjacent to the shops, which include a bakery, dairy, pharmacy and butchery.

Six parking spaces are currently marked outside these shops, three to the south from the intersection in Gayhurst Road and three to the east in McBratneys Road. It would be appropriate to designate these six parking spaces with a time limit. All the shop operators and the owner of the house at 48 McBratneys Road agree to this proposal.

The Parking Operations Manager is agreeable to the installation of a P10 parking restriction in this area.

Recommendation: That the Board recommends to Council the following parking restrictions be installed:

- 1. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes on the eastern side of Gayhurst Road commencing at a point 17 metres from its intersection with McBratneys Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 10 minutes on the southern side of McBratneys Road commencing at a point 27 metres from its intersection with Gayhurst Road and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 16 metres.

Chairperson'sRecommendation:That the aforementioned recommendations be adopted.
