

7. BAKER STREET - GIVE WAY SIGN

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to formalise the Give Way sign in Baker Street at the intersection with New Brighton Road.

The proposal to construct a traffic island on Baker Street was in response to residents concerns about traffic safety at the intersection, as shown in the North New Brighton Neighbourhood Improvement Plan. A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in September 1999. This work was completed in June 2000.

It is now appropriate to formalise the installation of the Give Way sign.

Recommendation: That the Board approve the installation of a “Give Way” sign in Baker Street at its intersection with New Brighton Road.
