

## 8. BELLAMY AVENUE - GIVE WAY SIGN

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to formalise the Give Way sign in Bellamy Avenue at the intersection with Estuary Road.

In the 2000/01 Capital Works programme it is proposed that the kerbs, channels, footpaths and berms in Estuary Road between Jervois Street and Bridge Street be renewed. As part of this work it is proposed that a traffic restraint and traffic controls on Bellamy Avenue be installed, in response to the resident's concerns for traffic safety at the intersection. A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in May 2000. The works are supported by the community and will be completed in December 2000.

It is now appropriate to formalise the installation of the Give Way sign.

**Recommendation:** That the Board approve the installation of a "Give Way" sign in Bellamy Avenue at its intersection with Estuary Road.

**Chairperson's Recommendation:** That the aforementioned recommendation be adopted.
