The purpose of this report is to approve the installation of 'Give Way' signs in Hampshire Street and Hulverstone Drive at their intersections with Wainoni Road.

Stage 1 of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway, from Travis Road to Wainoni Road, is expected to be open to traffic in February 2001. Part of this work is the installation of traffic signals at the Wainoni Road/ANZAC Drive/Bexley Road intersection, which will be operating from August/September 2000. A pamphlet showing the 'Give Way' controls was distributed to residents in November 1999 (*see [attachment](#)*).

The Council will also need to approve the installation of 'Give Way' signs in the left turn slip lanes at the traffic signals. The proposals are shown on the plan appended to this report.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the Board approve the installation of 'Give Way' signs in the following locations.
 - (a) Against Hampshire Street at its intersection with Wainoni Road.
 - (b) Against Hulverstone Drive at its intersection with Wainoni Road.
 2. That it be recommended to the Council that it approve the installation of 'Give Way' signs in the following locations.
 - (a) Against Wainoni Road west at its left turn slip lane into ANZAC Drive.
 - (b) Against Wainoni Road east at its left slip lane into Bexley Road.
