23. FERRY ROAD BUS STOPS

The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee of proposals to extend an existing bus stop in Ferry Road to accommodate three buses as part of the improvements to the public transport system.

This matter will be referred to the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board at its next meeting and is reported for information only.

It is proposed to extend the bus stop on the southern side of Ferry Road between Barbadoes Street and Williams Street to accommodate three buses. The existing bus stop is presently not being used, as a result of recent changes to the bus routes in this area and the existing parking spaces adjacent to it are unrestricted. A plan showing the location in respect to the overall peripheral termini location is attached.

The proposed bus stops have the support of the Christchurch Polytechnic, the adjacent property occupier, Environment Canterbury and the Parking Manager.

Details are:

- 1. A bus stop be created on the southern side of Ferry Road commencing at a point 15 metres measured in a westerly direction from a point opposite the western kerbline of Barbadoes Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres.
- 2. The existing bus stop in the above described area would be revoked.
