

4. BROWNS ROAD - KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the publicity plan for the renewal of the kerb and channel in Browns Road for distribution. Browns Road is a boundary Road between the Fendalton and Shirley Wards.

BACKGROUND

Browns Road is on the capital works programme to have its kerb and dish channel renewed for its full length from St Albans Street to Innes Road in the 2000/2001 financial year. Several options have been considered. Following a good response to an initial resident survey, a traffic survey was also carried out and the proposal as shown on the attached plan was then prepared.

The proposal features kerb extensions at all the intersections along Browns Road. The minimum widths at these kerb extensions are all set at eight metres wide to allow left and right turning vehicles to exit at the same time, but shall still reduce traffic speeds through the intersections. All speed humps shown exist at these locations at the present time.

PROPOSAL

To distribute the publicity plan showing the location of the proposed kerb and channel and associated works in Browns Road for public comment.

Recommendation: That the information be received and the publicity plan be circulated for public comment.
