The purpose of this report is to advise the Board of the outcomes from the 1999/2000 funding round.

This year there were 88 applications, a decrease of 27 on last year.

The Fendalton/Waimairi Community Funding Committee allocated a total of \$87,143 in community grants.

The following details the schemes amounts requested and allocated.

In addition, the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Funding Committee received two loan applications – both of which were successful. A total of \$105,000 was allocated in loans.

There was a balance of \$16,984.39 remaining of which \$13,019.39 is under the Community Development Scheme and \$3,965 under the Hillary Commission Scheme. These amounts will be carried over into next years funding round.

The Board's top-up funding of \$25,000 was also allocated in full.
