28. REPORT OF JOINT MEETING OF COMMUNITY BOARD REPRESENTATIVES TO DISCUSS WARD BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENTS

The purpose of this report is to bring to the Community Board the outcomes of an informal joint meeting held between representatives of the Spreydon/Heathcote, Burwood/Pegasus, Shirley/Papanui and Hagley/Ferrymead Community Boards on Thursday 29 June 2000 to discuss Ward boundary adjustments.

The discussion at the meeting traversed the following areas:

1. PLEASANT POINT YACHT CLUB AND ESTUARY EDGE

The proposal agreed upon was that the three meshblocks bordering the eastern edge of the Estuary and including the Pleasant Point Yacht Club be transferred from the Ferrymead Ward to the Pegasus Ward.

2. PROPOSAL TO INCLUDE THE SYDENHAM BUSINESS DISTRICT IN THE HEATHCOTE WARD

This proposal envisaged the transfer of the Sydenham Business District from the Hagley Ward to the Heathcote Ward.

3. PROPOSAL THAT THE WALTHAM AREA BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE HAGLEY WARD TO THE HEATHCOTE WARD

This proposal envisaged the transfer of four meshblocks in Waltham from the Hagley Ward to the Heathcote Ward.

4. PROPOSAL THAT THE AREA OF THE HEATHCOTE WARD BOUNDED BY THE RAILWAY LINE, CHAPMANS ROAD, PORT HILLS ROAD AND THEN FOLLOWING THE WARD BOUNDARY TO THE SUMMIT ROAD, BACK ALONG THE MESHBLOCK BOUNDARIES TO INCLUDE AVOCA VALLEY ROAD, PORT HILLS ROAD AND CURRIES ROAD BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE HEATHCOTE WARD TO THE FERRYMEAD WARD

A modified proposal was agreed upon at the meeting which would transfer two meshblocks, 2,553,702 and 2,554,200 from the Heathcote Ward to the Ferrymead Ward. This transfer would include the residential area of Avoca Valley Road but would exclude both sides of Port Hills Road from Avoca Valley Road to Curries Road and the block bounded by Port Hills Road, Curries Road, the railway line and Chapmans Road. These latter areas had been included in the original proposal by the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board.

5. PROPOSED ADJUSTMENT OF THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE HAGLEY WARD INTO THE RICHMOND AREA

The meeting agreed not to pursue this proposal further.

The full details of the meshblock areas to be transferred are given in the <u>attached report</u> of the meeting. Maps of the meshblock areas affected are also attached.
