The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of a P5 Loading Zone on the east side of Colombo Street to the south of Canon Street (see attached plan).

Long-term parking is spreading further along streets in the area between Bealey Avenue and Edgeware Road. Customers wanting to shop at the Edgeware Dairy near the corner of Canon Street are finding it difficult to find a place to stop, and have been causing problems by parking temporarily within the existing legal bus stop location.

The dairy owner has requested that a short term Loading Zone be created from the bus stop across the frontage of the property. A similar zone was created last year on the corner diagonally opposite and has operated efficiently but is too remote to be utilised by dairy customers.

The creation of this short term parking area would also assist buses with access from the bus stop. To allow the installation and marking of the parking zone, the bus stop will also have to be formally marked on the road.

As this part of Colombo Street is classified a Collector road, the Board's recommendation will be referred to the Council for resolution.

Recommendations: 1. That a Bus Stop be installed on the eastern side of Colombo Street commencing at a point 7 metres south from the intersection of Canon Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

2. That a Loading Zone time limit of 5 minutes be created on the eastern side of Colombo Street commencing at a point 24 metres south of the intersection with Canon Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.

Chairperson'sRecommendation:That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
