5.1 FIBRE OPTIC CABLE

5.2 PUKEKO DEATHS ON TRAVIS ROAD

The following letter was received from Rima Herber, Travis Wetland Trust, regarding Pukeko deaths on Travis Road:

“I am writing on behalf of the Travis Wetland Trust re a matter which was raised at our AGM at the end of last year. There have been many Pukeko deaths on Travis Road and the Trust would prefer that if any cycleways or walkways are to be created on Travis Road, that they are formed on the northern side of Travis Road, beside the Wetland. This would help to form a greater boundary between the road and the Wetland, which may discourage birds from going onto the road.

In our view, it would be preferable to have cycleways on both sides of the road, but if only one side of the road will get one, we ask that it be on the north side.”
