The purpose of this report is to provide an update on actions by the Canterbury Hazardous Waste Working Party.

A meeting of the Canterbury Hazardous Waste Working Party was held on Tuesday, 22 February 2000. At that meeting the Working Party approved final modifications to the policy framework for the Canterbury Hazardous Waste Management Strategy and received the outline of the implementation plan for that strategy.

The working party also resolved as follows:

“The Canterbury Hazardous Waste Working Party endorse the following contribution of external goods and services funding to implement new hazardous waste management programmes for the 2000/2001 financial year:

Canterbury Regional Council	50%	\$80,000
Christchurch City Council	20%	\$32,000
Timaru District Council	7%	\$11,200
Waimakariri District Council	5%	\$8,000
Ashburton & Selwyn district councils	(4% each) total 8%	\$6,400 each, total \$12,800
Banks Peninsula, Hurunui, Kaikoura, Mackenzie & Waimate district councils	(2% each) total 10%	\$3,200 each, total \$16,000
TOTAL	100%	\$160,000
