

16. GLOUCESTER STREET – MOBILITY PARK

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a mobility park be installed on Gloucester Street.

A request has been received from St George's Church on the corner of Gloucester Street and Linwood Avenue for assistance in providing parking for the elderly and disabled in their congregation. There are several members of the church that are having difficulty finding suitable parking close to the church buildings.

A mobility park would insure that there is a parking space available for the elderly or disabled who wish to attend services at St George's Church.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be restricted at all times to vehicles displaying a Mobility card, on the north west side of Gloucester Street commencing at a point 26.5 metres from its intersection with Linwood Avenue and extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of 6.5 metres.
