

9. NAMING OF RESERVES – STANMORE ROAD

The purpose of this report is to bring before the Board the opportunity to name two new reserves in Stanmore Road.

1. RESERVE CORNER STANMORE ROAD/TUAM STREET

This reserve is a residential neighbourhood reserve on the above corner. It will be landscaped and used for reserve purposes.

2. 84 STANMORE ROAD

This is also a residential neighbourhood adjacent to the Linwood Arts Centre on the corner of Stanmore and Worcester Streets.

A number of approaches could be made to seek suitable names for these two reserves.

- (a) Seek suggestions from the wider community.
- (b) Identify some local identities to name after.
- (c) Significant historic features of the community.

As a starting point for whatever approach the Board wish to make, I suggest the following two names for consideration.

(i) STANMORE/TUAM STREET

“Ernest Adams Reserve”

Ernest Adams was the founder of a local baking manufacturer of many years standing. With the company possibly relocating in the future due to takeovers etc it would be a shame to lose his identity with the area.

(ii) 84 STANMORE ROAD

“Linwood Arts Centre Reserve”

Adjacent to the Linwood Arts Centre with the development of the reserve likely to form a major interaction with the Centre when developed.
