

## 15. ST ANDREWS HILL ROAD – MOBILITY PARK

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a mobility park be installed on St Andrews Hill Road.

A request has been received from a resident in St Andrews Hill Road for assistance in coping with a disabled child. The child has to be lifted from a wheelchair into a van to be transported to school etc. on a regular basis.

The property is located close to a church and the area adjacent to the pedestrian entrance to the property, which is the flat part of the section, is often parked out.

A mobility park would insure that there is a parking space available for the transport vehicle for this child.

**Recommendation:** That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be restricted at all times to vehicles displaying a Mobility card, on the north east side of St Andrews Hill Road commencing at a point 66.5 metres from its intersection with Rangitira Terrace and extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of 6 metres.

**Chairman's Recommendation:** That the officer's recommendation be adopted.
