

## 12. WILSONS ROAD – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a P10 parking restriction be installed in Wilsons Road.

There is a food outlet in Wilsons Road near the railway line that serves the businesses in the area and through traffic on Wilsons Road. At present there is no restriction on parking on this section of Wilsons Road and it is quite often occupied all day. A P10 parking restriction would ease congestion that occurs outside this business and make parking available for short term transactions.

**Recommendation:** That the Board recommend to the Council That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 10 minutes on the west side of Wilsons Road commencing at a point 68 metres from its intersection with Mowbray Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 7 metres.

**Chairman's Recommendation:** That the above recommendation be adopted.
