11. GRIMSEYS ROAD - INTERSECTION CONTROLS AT DUNBARTON/FARQUHARS

The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's approval for the installation of Give Way and Stop sign controls against Grimseys Road at the intersection with Dunbarton Street and Farquhars Road.

As Grimseys Road and Farquhars Road are designated collector roads, these recommendations will be referred to the Council for resolution.

A recent injury crash at this intersection brought to our attention that Stop or Give Way signs do not control this crossroad intersection. The Police have asked that this matter be addressed.

The section of Grimseys Road north of this intersection currently serves only a few rural properties. It has been recommended that it be given the lowest priority and be controlled by a Stop sign. Drivers entering the intersection from this leg will then have to give way to all other traffic.

Placing a Give Way control against the southern Grimseys Road approach will give the desired priority to through traffic on Dunbarton Street and Farquhars Road and also turning traffic from Farquhars Road into Grimseys Road. Placing the limit lines at this location will help in dissuading motorists from cutting this corner.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the Council's approval be sought for the installation of a Stop sign against the northern approach of Grimseys Road at its intersection with Dunbarton Street and Farquhars Road.
- 2. That a Give Way sign be placed against the southern approach of Grimseys Road at its intersection with Dunbarton Street and Farquhars Road.
