The purpose of this report is to seek the Board's support for the installation of right turning arrows on Hills Road at its intersection with Warrington Street.

For some years now residents have complained about the difficulty of making right turns from Hills Road, from either approach, during peak hour traffic. They have experienced long delays, leading to driver frustration and risky manoeuvres. Property owners have difficulty in accessing their driveways due to the banked up vehicles. It is expected that the problem will be compounded with the opening of the proposed shopping development on the south east corner of the intersection, with cars entering and exiting the site.

It is considered that provision of right turning arrows during peak hour traffic would ease the congestion.

Recommendation: That consideration be given to the provision of right turning arrows on

both approaches of Hills Road at its intersection with Warrington

Street during the hours of 7.00 - 9.00 am and 4.00 - 6.00 pm.
