10. UXBRIDGE STREET PETITION- REDWOOD WEST LATMS

The purpose of this report is to outline to the Board the proposed traffic management scheme that should address the issues raised in the petition received from Uxbridge Street residents at the last Board meeting.

The City Streets Unit is currently starting the process of collecting information and initiating the public participation for the Redwood West Local Area traffic Management Plan. This is a continuation of the programme to provide local traffic management for all the suitable areas within the city. The Redwood West area is bounded by Northcote, Main North, Styx Mill and Cavendish Roads. Uxbridge Street runs north - south between Tuckers Road and Northcote Road in this LATMS area.

The collection of traffic speed and volumes information on the local roads for the scheme in this area will identify times and locations such as Uxbridge Street where vehicles area travelling at excessive speeds. This information will then be relayed to the Police so that they can effectively target the main offenders.

The development of the scheme will require a good level of community involvement. A public meeting will need to be convened to initially register the local traffic concerns of the residents. Residents groups and any schools near this area will be contacted and a letter box drop outlining information on the meeting will be made to all residents/property owners in this area.

The public meeting is envisaged to proceed through:

- Introduction
- LATMS presentation
- Public comment
- Summary and closing address

During the meeting Basil Pettigrew will take comprehensive notes which will be used to ensure that the relevant issues are addressed by the LATMS.

Recommendation:

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That a public meeting is convened in March to introduce the LATMS process and to record the traffic concerns of the residents.
