

**13. PROJECT FUNDS CARRY FORWARD  
– ART IN LOCAL AREA**

The purpose of this report is to recommend that Council be requested to authorise the carry-forward of a \$3,000 1999/2000 Project Fund allocation for art in public places.

The Board resolved that this allocation be used for a piece of art work to be installed in Addington. The Addington Business Association were to identify a suitable location and piece of art.

The Art in Public Places Committee has now advised that the sum of \$3,000 would not, on its own, be sufficient to provide a worthwhile sculpture. An amount of between \$10,000 and \$20,000 would be required. In discussion with the Business Association it has been agreed that there is insufficient time before the end of this financial year to raise the additional funding required, and that even with additional time it is unlikely that sufficient funding could be achieved by the Business Association. Alternative means of enhancing the environment are being investigated but no firm proposals are yet available, and accordingly, a carry forward is requested.

**Recommendation:** That Board Project Funds of \$15,000 allocated to “Art in Local Area” be carried forward to 2000/2001.
