The Working Party has requested that the Residents' Association reconsider its involvement when the road design has been confirmed and the focus again turns to wider New Brighton development issues.

The Chairperson and Glenda Burt recently attended a meeting on the future establishment and ongoing management of Neighbourhood Support Groups in Christchurch and surrounding areas. The meeting agreed to the establishment of a regional committee with two representatives from each police district, Chrissie Williams and Constable Robbie Brine (Rangiora) agreed to be the Burwood/Pegasus representatives.
