The purpose of this report is to suggest a process to enable the Board to provide input to the draft Christchurch City Council Plan 2000 Edition. A copy of the capital works projects specific to the Burwood/Pegasus area are specified in the draft Christchurch City Council 2000 Community Plans, pages 4-15.

The timetable for the balance of the programme leading up to final adoption of the Plan is as follows:

29 May	Closing date for submissions
16 to 21 June	Hearing of Submissions
6 July	Council meeting to adopt final version of the Plan

All Board members have received copies of both the draft Christchurch City Council Plan and the Burwood/Pegasus Community Plan. The process from here is to discuss the Strategic Elements and Forward Capital Programme in particular to assess if they align with the community's perceived focus and direction.

Insofar as consideration of the Forward Capital Programme is concerned the Board has the opportunity to consider its priority list formulated at the August Capital Works Submission Special Meeting and resubmit those projects that were not included in the draft Annual Plan. A copy of the Board's priority list is attached. The Board also has the opportunity to place submissions on the timing of works, for example it may see a project that is allocated to the 2003/04 financial year that it wants brought forward to the 2002/03 financial year.

As a starting point the Chairperson has suggested that the following topics be discussed:

- Travis Road cycleway

- Bus shelters more needed
- Cycleways generally need more?
- Bexley Wetlands removal of contaminates ex Cunningham's yard
- Irrigation of Ascot Fields
- QEII retention of public access to fields area local park
