

## 32. NEW TRADE WASTES BYLAW

The purpose of this report is to inform the Council of progress towards adopting a new Trade Wastes Bylaw.

In December 1999 the Council adopted a draft version of the new Trade Wastes Bylaw for the purpose of inviting submissions, and appointed a subcommittee of Councillors Howell, Evans and O'Rourke to hear submissions on the draft bylaw.

Seven submissions have been received and the hearings will be held in the first week of May. It is envisaged that the hearings subcommittee will make any changes that are needed and report direct to the Council at its meeting on 25 May, enabling the final stages of public advertisement and Ministerial comment to be implemented. This will enable the bylaw to be in place by 1 July for the start of the 2000/01 financial year.
