

8. FERRY ROAD – PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a P10 parking restriction be installed in Ferry Road.

There is a food outlet in Ferry Road near the intersection with Phillips Street that serves the businesses in the area and through traffic on Ferry Road. At present there is no restriction on parking on this section on Ferry Road and it is quite often occupied all day as it is near the Polytechnic.

A P10 parking restriction would ease congestion in the area between Phillips Street and the pedestrian refuge near by, as well as making parking available for short term transactions.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum of 10 minutes on the north side of Ferry Road commencing at a point 6 metres from its intersection with Phillips Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 17 metres.

Chairman's Recommendation: That the Officer's recommendation be adopted.
