The purpose of this report is to seek approval of the Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan – Part 2 Action Plans for the financial year 2001/02.

BACKGROUND

At a City Services Committee seminar on 24 October 2000 it was agreed that the Council's Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Plan be restructured into two parts.

Part 1 will be the plan adopted in 1998 (due for revision in 2003). This part deals with high level overarching vision, goals and the international waste management 5R hierarchy of reduction, reuse, recycling, resource recovery and residue disposal.

Part 2 is called Action Plans and deals with specific upcoming targets that the Council will strive to implement in the drive towards the vision and goals outlined in Part 1 (and in particular zero waste to landfill by 2020).
