

5. BISHOPDALE MALL – PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to request that the Board approve the installation of a no stopping restriction on the eastern side of the service lane behind No's 115 to 121 Farrington Avenue.

BACKGROUND

A request has been received for the installation of a no stopping restriction on one side to allow two way access into and out of the service lane at all times. At present this area tends to attract parking on both sides of the lane by service contactors/delivery agents for/to the shops. The local Harcourt's agency has surveyed all businesses affected and all have signed the sketch that they are in agreement with the proposal.

PROPOSAL

To stop on street parking on the south east side of the southern public service lane in Bishopdale Mall behind the properties of No's 115 to 121 Farrington Avenue.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the south east side of the southern service lane in Bishopdale Mall commencing at the south western corner of No.115 Farrington Avenue and extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of 24.0 metres.

Deputy Chairman's Recommendation: That the foregoing recommendation be adopted.
