**1. FENDALTON/WAIMAIRI COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS PROVIDING
COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES - UPDATE**

The Community Development Adviser submitted an update report setting out information relating to the local organisations working to provide for the social and developmental needs of the Fendalton/Waimairi community.

Specific mention was made of the Bishopdale School Community Development Project, the Bishopdale, Bryndwr and Avonhead Community Trusts, the North West Youth Trust, Te Ropu Tamahine, the Asian Youth Project and the Christchurch North Citizens Advice Bureau.

Arising from the discussion on the report, staff undertook to report back to the Committee early in the new year with recommendations on the possible allocation of the Board's remaining 2000/2001 funding to support such community organisations.
