11. BEALEY AVENUE PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to ask the Board to recommend to the Council that a P60 parking restriction be installed in Bealey Avenue.

A new office complex has been established in the heritage buildings on the corner of Bealey Avenue and Dublin Street. The parking along the frontages of both streets at present provides parking for commuters. It has been requested that some short term parking be provided to help revitalise these buildings.

There is a small amount of short term parking on the west side of Dublin Street but this is not enough to serve these new businesses. To allow for a reasonable turn over in parking in the area in front of the buildings and access for customers to these businesses a parking restriction needs to be imposed on the south side of Bealey Avenue between the bus stop and the corner of Dublin Street.

Recommendation: That the Board recommend to the Council that the parking of vehicles

be restricted to a maximum of 60 minutes on the south side of Bealey Avenue commencing at a point 11m from its intersection with Dublin Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 27.5

metres.
