The purpose of this report is to inform the Board of the successful completion of the Hagley/Ferrymead Heritage Awards for the Year 2000.

The Heritage Awards Ceremony was held in the Moorhouse Railway Station at Ferrymead Historic Park on Thursday 19 October 2000, commencing at 6.00pm. Guests were conveyed to the ceremony in two tramcars provided by the Tramway Historical Society Inc. One of these tramcars was Christchurch Electric Tramcar No 1, the recipient of a Heritage Restoration Certificate in a previous year. Both tram drivers were dressed in appropriate uniforms.

The venue was a period railway refreshment room. A beautiful mild and sunny evening allowed guests to spill out of the main doorway of the refreshment room and on to the railway platform.

Guests were most appreciative of the appropriate heritage ambience of both the railway station and of the period tramcar which conveyed them to the cemetery.

The Community Board chairman welcomed guests to the ceremony and acted as Master of Ceremonies. Jenny May, Senior Heritage Planner, introduced the judges and spoke briefly before the presentation of heritage tiles to the judges as an appreciation of their service from the Community Board.
