

18. FERRY ROAD – ERECTION OF SIGNAGE

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for the erection of signage at each end of the Woolston Shopping area.

As part of the Mainstreet programme for Woolston, the community is seeking permission to erect a sign at each end of the shopping area. The sign has the Woolston Mainstreet logo and the wording Woolston on the front and on the reverse side will have “Thank you for visiting Woolston” (see attached Plan).

It is proposed to place one sign at the western end of the shopping on the kerb build-out outside number 651. The second sign at the eastern end of the area is to be placed outside number 664 or 666.

Permission is being sought from property owners where it is proposed to place the signs and as long as this is obtained, I would recommend that approval be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That the sign meet the planning regulation for size, colouring, and lettering.
2. That the lower edge of the sign be a minimum of 2.2metres minimum above the footpath.
3. That the sign be erected 300mm behind the kerbline.
4. That Woolston Mainstreet Inc. be entirely responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the sign.

Recommendation: That the Board approve the erection of two signs as shown on the plan subject to the conditions 1 to 4 as outlined in the report.
