

24. REQUEST FOR USE OF FERRYMEAD RESERVE TRAM LINE

The purpose of this report is to seek the appointment of a subcommittee to consider an application for the use of the Ferrymead Reserve Tram Line.

A letter has been received from the Tramway Historical Society Inc seeking approval for the use of the Ferrymead Reserve tram line between the hours of 9.30am and 6pm for all tram cars, including the steam tram as part of the celebrations of Canterbury Anniversary Day – 150 years since the arrival of the first of the first four ships – on Saturday 16 December 2000.

The Board appointed a Ferrymead Tram Line subcommittee of Bob Todd and John Freeman on 25 November 1997 to consider such requests. It is sometime since a request for the use of this tram line was received from the Tramway Historical Society.

The Board may wish to deal with this request by re-appointing a subcommittee and authorising it to make a decision on this request.
