

6. AWATEA RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION – REQUEST FOR OFFICIAL RECOGNITION

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The purpose of this report is to seek Board recognition and approval of the recently formed Awatea Residents' Association.

The Awatea Residents' Association has confirmed their boundaries and now seek official recognition from the Community Board.

BOUNDARIES OF ASSOCIATION

The area bounded by Wigram Road (north west side of Wigram Road from Awatea Road to Halswell Junction Road), Awatea Road, Wilmers Road and Halswell Junction Road (from Wilmers Road to Wigram Road). **Map attached.**

This area is part of the Wigram/Halswell Rural Districts Residents' Group which is in the process of going into recession.

FUNDING

The group has applied for a seeding grant of \$350.00 to cover the cost of becoming an incorporated society and other administrative costs.
