

12. WADES AVENUE – P30 PARKING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval for a parking restriction of 30 minutes in Wades Avenue, adjacent to the St Martins Children’s Library.

A request has been received from the Community Librarian at the St Martins Children’s Library to provide time restricted parking outside the library in Wades Avenue. At present the library does not have any on-site car parking, with users having to park kerb side. With the current redevelopment of the New World supermarket at the St Martins Shopping Centre, the existing car park for the centre has been temporarily restricted in size. Staff are now parking off-site to provide parking for shoppers. This has caused all day parking outside the library.

To help alleviate the parking problem for library users time restricted parking should be installed adjacent to the library site. The proposed P30 restriction would provide for parking for five vehicles.

Recommendation: That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 30 minutes on the north side of Wades Avenue, commencing at a point 6 metres from its intersection with Wilsons Road and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
