

13. PROPOSED NEW ROAD NAMES

The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval of the Board to five new road names.

BUR 20000377 - Mairehau Road (Ngai Tahu Property Group) - Burwood Ward

This subdivision is the first stage of the subdivision of the land adjacent to Burwood Hospital, and will create five new roads to serve 110 new allotments. The names supplied are all Maori names as requested by the Board. The following names are submitted: Tanu; Putake; Puhara; Amoka and Mahuri. Four other names were submitted but were deemed to be too close to existing names in appearance or pronunciation (Ruawai - Riwai exist; Tumara - Te Maru exist; Taramoa - Taramoa exist; Kanuka - Kanuku and Manuka exist). The descriptive suffixes will be added once it is known which names are approved. The names proposed have the following meaning: Tanu - swamp plant; Putake - bushy flax; Puhara - coastal bush; Amoka - tall totara; and Mahuri - young sapling.

Recommendation: That the Board approve the names Tanu; Putake; Puhara; Amoka and Mahuri for the five new roads in the first stage of this subdivision.
