- 14.4 **BOTTLE LAKE FOREST PUBLICATION**

Board members will recall that Ian Surgenor, Parks Ranger Bottle Lake Forest, approached the Board for support in the production of a book on the history of the Bottle Lake Forest.

The Board whilst not providing funds at the time proposed that copies would be purchased when available and be donated to appropriate community groups. The original approach for support was for a grant of \$1,000 to assist with the production and publication of the book.

14.5 **CENTRAL CITY REVITALISATION STRATEGY**

At the request of the Central City Mayoral Forum meetings were arranged for both the Burwood ward and Pegasus ward to provide an opportunity for discussion on the vision for the revitalisation of the Central City.

David Close chaired the Pegasus ward meeting on 10 October and Don Rowlands the Burwood ward meeting on 11 October.

Although both meetings did not receive a large attendance the persons present engaged in a fruitful dialogue on the issues.

Comment on the proposals have been sought by 30 November 2000 through a feedback form (copy to be tabled).

Some Residents' Associations, including Windsor/Westhaven and Golf Links, are arranging specific meetings to be briefed on and/or discuss the proposals.

Recommendations: That the Board promote the publication by advertising in the Pegasus Post and provide up to \$300 from Discretionary funds for this purpose.
