7. SAFFRON STREET/GREERS ROAD - PROPOSED NO STOPPING RESTRICTION

The purpose of this report is to consider the installation of a no-stopping restriction on both sides of Saffron Street at its intersection with Greers Road.

BACKGROUND

It has been reported that at times there is parking on both sides of Saffron Street (a local road) at its intersection with Greers Road (a collector road). The Area Engineer has visited the site and the report has been confirmed. When this occurs it is difficult for a vehicle to enter Saffron Street at the same time as one is waiting to leave. If vehicles park right up to the intersection in Greers Road the sight lines along Greers Road become inadequate for a driver wishing to turn right out of Saffron Street.

PROPOSAL

To enable vehicles to enter and leave Saffron Street at the same time, the stopping of vehicles on both sides of Saffron Street needs to be prohibited. To provide adequate sight distances, the stopping of vehicles also needs to be prohibited on the east side of Greers Road from Saffron Street for a distance of 16.0 metres to the north.

Recommendation:

That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the: -

- south side of Saffron Street commencing 11 metres east of its intersection with Greers Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 17.0 metres.
- north side of Saffron Street commencing 6.0 metres east of its intersection with Greers Road and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 26.0 metres.
