

19. ST ALBANS RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION - BOUNDARY CHANGES

The purpose of this report is to seek the Boards support to change the boundaries of the St Albans Residents Association.

The St Albans Residents Association has advised as follows:

"When the St Albans Residents Association redefined itself in 1996, the boundaries chosen at the time were to accommodate the wishes of some residents in Winters Road. The Residents Association has felt for some time that these boundaries have been too wide.

We are delighted to hear that a new residents groups has started up in the Redwood area which includes Winters Road in their boundaries.

After a discussion at our last meeting, we would like to give the Council formal notice of reducing our boundaries in line with the circulation of STANN - which is:

- *Innes Road in the north*
- *Hills Road in the East*
- *Bealey Avenue in the south*
- *Springfield Road in the west*

In practice these have been the boundaries for a while. Could you please advise us as to what our responsibilities are (if any) regarding the notification of the public."

It should be noted that the inclusion of Winters Road in the Redwood Residents Association is just the area within the Papanui Ward, between Queen Elizabeth II Drive and Cranford Street.

It would be appropriate to form a new residents group, however this would not be possible now until February of next year, due to other programmed work. In the meantime, if the Board agrees to the boundary changes, notification could be given through STANN, and interest sought from within the area removed from SARA.

Recommendation: That interest be sought to the formation of a new residents group within the area from Innes Road to Queen Elizabeth II Drive and Cranford Street, including the areas not covered by other residents groups.
