The purpose of this report is to seek Board approval to install a 'Give Way' sign in Radiata Avenue at the intersection of Queenspark Drive.

The proposal to construct a traffic island on Radiata Avenue, was in response to traffic safety concerns, as shown in the Parklands Local Area Traffic Management Scheme, and was identified in the Safer Routes to School Programme. A pamphlet explaining the proposed work was distributed to residents in March 2000. The work was supported by the community and will be completed in October 2000.

The installation of a 'Give Way' control will improve the safety at this intersection.

Recommendation: That a 'Give Way' sign be placed against Radiata Avenue at its

intersection with Queenspark Drive.
