

16. SPRINGFIELD ROAD PEDESTRIAN CROSSING FACILITY

The purpose of this report is to inform the Committee of the recommendation of the Shirley/Papanui Community Board regarding pedestrian crossing facilities in Springfield Road.

Attached is a copy of the report considered by the Board at its meeting on 2 August 2000 together with a summary of its recommendation to the City Services Committee.

The recommendation from the Board was:

1. That the intersection of Abberley/Edgware/Springfield Roads be signalised for the purpose of providing safe pedestrian facilities.
2. That funding options for the provision of traffic signals at Abberley/Edgware/Springfield Roads be further investigated.
3. That an information leaflet be circulated to the residents for comment and if necessary a further public meeting be held so that the views of the residents on these proposals can be heard in detail.
