4. GRAHAMS ROAD/GREERS ROAD - UPDATE

Members will recall that the Board, at its 1 August meeting, received a report relating to concerns at a number of crashes that had been occurring at the Grahams/Greers intersection. In consideration of this report the Board resolved that it be recommended to the City Services Committee that the short term improvements set out be endorsed, but that any longer term alterations await the outcome of the overall review of the city's ring road system.

Following recent consideration of the matter by the City Services Committee, and the Council, it was resolved as follows:

- That the identified low cost safety improvements be proceeded with.
- That the "Give Way" sign against Greers Road (south) at its intersection with Grahams Road be removed and replaced with a "Stop" sign.
- That these measures be reviewed after eight months.
- That ripple strips be trialled at this intersection after consultation with the residents.
- That before any overall review of the city's ring road system is commenced, a report be obtained on the estimated cost of the longer term options suggested in the crash reduction study, as set out on pages 125 and 126 of the (Council) agenda.

Recommendation: That the information be received.
