

11. WALLER TERRACE GOODS SERVICE VEHICLE LOADING ZONE

The purpose of this report is to create a goods service vehicle loading zone in Waller Terrace.

To assist with the movement of large articulated vehicles and to create an area for service vehicles, it is proposed to create a goods service vehicle loading zone on the southern side of Waller Terrace adjacent to the 90 degree bend in the street. The area where the loading zone is to be created is presently used for on street parking.

The proposed restriction has the support of the two adjacent businesses and the Parking Manager.

Recommendation: That a loading zone for goods services only be created on the southern side of Waller Terrace commencing at a point 6 metres measured in a south easterly direction from a point opposite the eastern side of Selwyn Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance for a distance of 9 metres.
