

### 13. PROPOSED NEW ROAD NAMES

The purpose of this report is to obtain the approval of the Board to three new road names.

WIG/2000/523 Wigram Aerodrome Limited Springs Road, Wigram Ward.

A further stage of the subdivision of Wigram Base creates further roads requiring naming. The applicant company have continued the theme of using the names of military aircraft, with one exception.

The name Corsair was approved by the Board on 2 September 1998, with the applicant's intention being to substitute Corsair for the existing name Grebe. The company has since changed it's mind and wishes to retain Grebe, but will use the name CORSAIR DRIVE for the new access road. The new names proposed are MUSTANG AVENUE, for the new road off Corsair Drive. (This road will be extended in the future)

JOE BURNS PLACE for a new cul de sac off Caudron Road. The use of this name is at the Boards request. (This retains the name of local identity Joe Burns, after a small existing road bearing the name was stopped recently)

Two names have been provided for another road running off Caudron Road, LIGHTNING WAY or HURRICANE WAY. The Board is asked to select one of these names for this road. The surplus name could be held for a further stage of the subdivision.

A plan showing the residential layout with the above roads identified is attached.

**Recommendation:** That the Board approve the proposed names as set out above.
